



YARD WASTE DISPOSAL REQUIREMENTS

Any debris resulting from work performed by a contractor (landscaper, tree service, etc.) must be removed by the contractor and not left at the curb as the City will not pick up debris left by a contractor.

1. All material shall be cut to no longer than 4-foot lengths and be neatly stacked by the curb at least 4 feet away from any objects such as mailboxes, water meters and low-hanging branches.
2. Any limbs more than 6 inches in diameter will not be collected and must be removed by the property owner at their expense.
3. All tree removals requires a permit from Clermont's Planning and Development Department located at City Hall, 685 W. Montrose Street. All tree debris must be removed by the property owner at their expense.
4. All other small materials (leaves, bushes, etc.) should be bagged. Bags should not weigh more than 50 lbs. each and should be neatly stacked by the curb at least 4 feet away from any objects such as mailboxes, water meters and low hanging branches.
5. All yard trash will be collected on your normal trash day, just by a different truck – usually later in the day.
